How it works

1. Set up your course

Courses and series are provisioned once, centrally or by a teacher.

2. Issue each student an ID

A QR code, an NFC tag, or both — nothing for the student to install.

3. Take attendance in class

Tap, scan, or mark manually — whichever fits the room.

4. Review and export

Synced records, per-student history, and one-click exports.

What it includes

- ✓ Three ways to check in: NFC tag, QR code, or manual tap
- ✓ A unique QR code or NFC tag per student, linked all year
- ✓ Digital passes for Apple Wallet and Google Wallet
- ✓ Cloud sync with a local-first safety net — a dropped connection never loses a class
- ✓ Per-student history and one-click exports to Excel
- ✓ Role-based access, so student data stays visible only to authorised staff
- ✓ Recurring schedules with a month, week, and day calendar
- ✓ Session reminders and announcements as notifications
- ✓ Anonymized exports that use student codes instead of names

What works on which platform

My NFC Attendance ships as a native mobile app and as a browser-based web app on the same account and the same backend. Most capabilities match — a few depend on what the device and browser actually support, so here it is plainly rather than glossed over.

Capability	Mobile app (iOS & Android)	Web app (browser)
NFC tap to mark attendance	Yes — iOS and Android	Android only, in Chrome or Edge — no browser exposes NFC to a website on iOS, Safari, Firefox, or desktop
QR code scanning	Yes	Yes, in any modern browser
Manual attendance marking	Yes	Yes
Bulk NFC tag writing for a class	Yes	Android only, in Chrome or Edge
Passwordless NFC tag login	Yes	Android only, in Chrome or Edge

Capability	Mobile app (iOS & Android)	Web app (browser)
Add pass to Apple Wallet	Yes — one tap, on iOS	Best-effort on iPhone Safari — opens a share sheet rather than a guaranteed one-tap install
Add pass to Google Wallet	Yes, on Android	Yes
Biometric app lock	Yes	Not applicable — browsers have no equivalent
Course, series & roster management	Yes	Yes
Excel import & catalog exports	Yes	Yes
Nothing to install	No — requires an app store install	Yes — open the URL in a browser; can also be installed as a Progressive Web App

Homerooms and period changes, with cards for students who don't carry a phone.

Universities

Courses, seminars, and labs, with merged sessions across cohorts.

Corporate training

Session-by-session attendance for compliance and certification records.
